Ichinohe Tourist Observatory

Yuhazu Spring

About 15 min walk to Mido from Kenpoku Bus' Nakayama stop. The medieval general Sakanoue no Tamuramaro enshrined a Buddhist Kannon statue here in gratitude for a victory in battle.

Within the precinct is Yuhazu Spring, the source of the Kitakami River, known for its legendary role in the Zenkunen War of 1051. At nearby Kawano Station, you can take a leisurely walk, enjoy the pleasant scenery, or just relax by the water.
